**Minutes for the Meeting**  
**of the Governing Body**  
**Tuesday January 21, 2014**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Robert Sims at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmen; Randy Jackson, Randy Ming, Gary Burkdoll and Councilwoman Jennifer Burkdoll. Councilman Hulsopple absent. Employees; Bobi Morris, Larry Alexander and Scott Lester. Citizens; Tom Carnes, Ted McDaniel and Cody Billingsley.

A motion was made by Councilman Burkdoll to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of January 7, 2014 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 4 – 0

**Old Business:** Pat Cox from BG Consultants gave the council an update on the status of the water project.

**New Business:** Mayor Sims recognized Sheriff Laurie Dunn. Sheriff Dunn discussed new radios her department was purchasing and the difference from the current models.

Cody Billingsley addressed the council about remarks made by the fire chief, Ken Croucher.

Scott Lester discussed the cost for new electric service needed at the Ottawa CO-OP. Council instructed Scott to inform the owners of the CO-OP that any cost was their responsibility.

Council approved entering into an agreement with the American Red Cross to provide a building in an emergency.

Larry Alexander will be attending the County-Wide emergency management exercise.

St Patrick's Church will be getting an electric refund applied to their account for a two year over charge.

Councilman Jackson made a motion at 8:15 p.m. to go in to a fifteen-minute executive session with City attorney Todd Luckman and city clerk Bobi Morris for non-elected personnel issues. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 8:30 p.m.

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion at 8:33 p.m. to go in to a fifteen-minute executive session with Todd Luckman, chief of police Larry Alexander and maintenance supervisor Scott Lester to discuss non-elected personnel issue. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 8:48 p.m.

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to terminate Dean Atchison. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0. Dean Atchison was invited to attend the hearing and declined.

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to approve \$250.00 for material so the maintenance department can replace the roof on the dog kennel. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 4 – 0.

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to have the city clerk purchase a multi-pack of black printer ink from Sam's Club for the fire department. Motion was second by councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0.

Councilman Jackson made a motion to approve \$130.00 to buy a used universal cage for the police department from Ray Hacks. Motion second by Councilman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0.

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to approve ordinances 3 & 4 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 9:05 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 4 – 0
