

**City of Scranton**  
**Minutes for the Meeting  
of the Governing Body  
Tuesday March 3, 2015**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Sims at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmen; Randy Ming, Gary Burkdoll and Jennifer Burkdoll. Councilman Jackson absent. Employees; Ted McDaniel, Scott Lester and Bobi Morris. Citizen; Tom Carnes, Gabe Faimon, Joe & Joyce Greene, John Blessing and Ken Croucher.

A motion was made by Councilman Burkdoll to approve the minutes for the special call meeting of February 24, 2015 as amended. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 3 – 0

**Old Business:** Culvert at 6<sup>th</sup> & Burlingame has been opened.

Water Tower insurance tabled.

Chief Cox was instructed to address the dog issue at 414 E 4<sup>th</sup> street and follow city code regarding the amount of time allowed to resolve the issues.

**New Business:** Council reviewed a contract from Osage Waste Disposal and an estimate for solid waste removal from Deffenbaugh Industries.

Councilman Ming made a motion to accept the contract with Osage Waste Disposal from May 1, 2015 through April 30, 2017 to provide the city's solid waste removal services. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 3 – 0

Councilman Ming made a motion to approve Kyle Cox to attend water training class in Topeka and if he cannot attend that class he will be allowed to attend training in Osage City. Councilman Ming amended his motion to exclude the training in Osage City. Motion was second by Councilman Burkdoll. Council man Ming amended his motion again to include sending Bruce Jolly to the Topeka training. Councilman Burkdoll second the amendment. Carried 3 – 1 (J. Burkdoll)

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to authorize the fire chief to purchase Sea-foam (fuel additive) from O'Reilly's not to exceed \$90.00. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 3 – 0

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to approve four (4) cases of pop and four (4) cases of water from Sam's not to exceed \$60.00. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 3 – 0

Discussion on a toolbox for the fire department was tabled.

Councilman Ming made a motion to approve the purchase of two (2) radios for the police cars in the amount of \$1150.00. Motion was second by Councilman Burkdoll. Carried 3 – 0

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to pay Officer Jordan Best forty (40) hours a week while he is in attendance at a two (2) week part-time police officer academy. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 3 – 0

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to authorize the mayor to approve the psychological tests for the part-time police officers if the tests cannot be administered by the police chief. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 3 – 0

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to authorize city attorney, Todd Luckman, to address rate increases on behalf of the City with the Rural Water District #5. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 3 – 0

Councilman Ming made a motion to donate \$400.00 to the Cross Road church for the annual Easter Egg Hunt. Motion was second by Councilman Burkdoll. Carried 3 – 0

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion at 7:50 p.m. to go in to a fifteen-minute executive session to discuss non-elected personnel issues with the ability to call in the maintenance supervisor. Second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 3 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 8:06 p.m.

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to approve ordinances 9 & 10 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 3 – 0

Councilman Ming made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 8:08 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Burkdoll. Carried 3 – 0
