**Minutes for the Meeting  
of the Governing Body  
Tuesday March 4, 2014**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Robert Sims at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmen; Larry Hulsopple, Randy Ming, Gary Burkdoll and Councilwoman Jennifer Burkdoll. Councilman Jackson absent. Employees; Bobi Morris, and Larry Alexander. Citizens; Tom Carnes, Carl Wall, Merlin Wall, Marcina Wall, Gabe Faimon, Ken Croucher, Marshall Madill and Ted McDaniel.

A motion was made by Councilman Burkdoll to approve the minutes for the special call meeting of February 11, 2014 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0

**Old Business:** Marshall Madill presented the 2014 insurance coverage to the council. Coverage will be with the EMC Insurance Company.

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to accept the bid from the EMC Insurance Company for \$19,080.00. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 - 0

**New Business:** Mayor Sims recognized Carl Wall who addressed the council about his new Tire & Lube shop to be located on Brownie Boulevard. Opening on April 1, 2014.

Dan Rukes requested the city continue supporting the Guide to Osage County published bi-annually with their full page ad.

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to continue the city's ad in the Guide to Osage County for \$695.00. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0

Ken Croucher gave the Fire report.

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to approve \$716.00 for the fire department to purchase six radio batteries (\$450.00), send eight firefighters to the SCAFFA School (\$200.00) and annual membership dues to the Kansas State Firefighter Association (\$66.00). Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion at 7:37 p.m. to go in to a five-minute executive session with Ken Croucher and Ted McDaniel to discuss non-elected personnel issue. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0. Council returned at 7:42 p.m.

Larry Alexander gave the police report.

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to approve spending up to \$1000.00 at the Santa Fe Trail body shop to repair the damage to the rear bumper of the 2008 police car. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to make a \$200.00 donation to the Santa Fe Trail High School After-Prom Party. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0

Councilwoman Burkdoll made a motion at 8:10 p.m. to go in to a five-minute executive session with Bobi Morris present to discuss non-elected personnel. Motion was second by Councilman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 8:14 p.m.

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to approve ordinances 7,8,9 & 10 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 8:17 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 4 – 0
