**Minutes for the Meeting
of the Governing Body
Tuesday June 17, 2014**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Robert Sims at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmen; Larry Hulsopple, Randy Ming, Gary Burkdoll and Jennifer Burkdoll. Councilman Jackson was absent. Employees; Larry Alexander, Scott Lester & Bobi Morris. Citizens; Ken Croucher, Tom Carnes, John Hauck, LaDonna Lee, Amanda Alexander, Veronica Delaney & Gabe Faimon.

A motion was made by Councilman Hulsopple to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of June 3, 2014 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Burkdoll Carried 4 - 0

Old Business; BG Engineers discussed options for the water line placement.

LaDonna Lee was recognized and she discussed the city ordinance that doesn't allow single wide mobile homes to be placed in the city except in the mobile home parks.

Gutter for the maintenance shop tabled to allow for inspection of the rafters.

City attorney Todd Luckman will send notice to Roger Edgar (property owner of 115 N East Ave.) regarding access to the property for utility inspection.

Chief Alexander will investigate the living situation on Brownie Blvd.

New Business; Veronica Delaney was recognized by Mayor Sims. Ms. DeLaney wanted to clarify that she did not live in the camper located at 414 W Evergreen St. like the article in the local paper stated. She discussed the temporary electric service at the same address and council agreed to leave the service on.

John Hauck asked the council if he could live in a camper for two years while he was repairing the house at 803 E 2nd St. Council denied him. Temporary utility service will not be supplied until the building permit has been issued. Mr. Hauck will need to present the contract for deed when he applies for a building permit.

Ken Croucher displayed the newly acquired fire equipment.

Councilman Ming made a motion to approve spending up to \$200.00 on ammunition for the police department. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion at 9:09 p.m. to go in to a fifteen-minute executive session with Todd Luckman and the right to call in Larry Alexander to discuss non-elected personnel issue. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0 Council returned to regular session at 9:24 p.m.

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion at 9:26 p.m. to go in to a ten-minute executive session with Todd Luckman and the right to call in Larry Alexander to discuss non-elected personnel issue.

Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0 Council returned to regular session at 9:36 p.m.

Scott Lester discussed the sewer back up caused by the recent flooding. Scott will get with Sam Johnson of BG Consultants about the issue.

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to approve ordinances 23 & 24 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 9:58 p.m. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 0
