

**City of Scranton**  
**Minutes for the Meeting  
of the Governing Body  
Tuesday June 17, 2008**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Gary Burkdoll at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were; Councilmen Ken Croucher, Eddie Lester, David Barnes, Larry Hulsopple, and Jack Mayfield employees Scott Lester, Bobi Morris, Brenda Lester, and Mark Knowles citizens Tom Carnes, Betsy & Keith Crispin, Gary DeShazer, Chad Myrick, Phil Parsons, Jennifer Burkdoll, Nick Stout, and Dennis Cowley.

A motion was made by Councilman Hulsopple to approve the minutes for the regularly scheduled meeting on June 3, 2008 as amended. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Motion carried 3 – 2. (Barnes, Lester)

**Old Business;** Council discussed work comp for Fireman.

**New Business;** Mayor Burkdoll recognized Tony Roberts. Mr. Roberts addressed ordinance 576, the age limit of homes brought into the city limits. A motion was made by Councilman Lester to table the issue until the next meeting so the zoning board members, Mr. and Mrs. Franks, and property owners near the property in question could be invited to the meeting to discuss the issue. Motion seconded by Councilman Barnes. Motion carried 5 – 0

Mayor Burkdoll recognized Councilman Mayfield. Councilman Mayfield stated that the attorney can take care of his legal issue.

Mayor Burkdoll recognized Councilman Mayfield. Councilman Mayfield had legal concerns. City attorney Mark Works advised the council that they should go into an executive session to discuss the issue. A motion was made by Councilman Lester to turn the lawsuit over to the insurance company. Motion seconded by Councilman Croucher. Motion carried 4 – 1 (Croucher)

Mayor Burkdoll recognized Councilman Croucher. Councilman Croucher inquired about the status of the emergency sirens. Police Chief Knowles advised the council that the West siren works and the East does not. Chief Knowles will check on funding for new sirens.

Mayor Burkdoll recognized Councilman Croucher. There was a discussion about the street repairs.

Mayor Burkdoll recognized Councilman Croucher. After a discussion about KPP Mayor Burkdoll instructed the clerk to invite Colin Whitley to the next meeting.

Mayor Burkdoll recognized Councilman Croucher. There was a discussion about reading the literature provided to each councilman and attending training classes when ever possible. A motion was made by Councilman Mayfield to purchase 10 Code of procedure books from the League of Kansas Municipalities at \$5.00 per book plus shipping. Motion seconded by Councilman Croucher. Motion carried 5 – 0

Mayor Burkdoll recognized Councilman Croucher. Councilman Croucher wants mileage reimbursed to anyone attending training meetings without going through the council to get approval. The council unanimously agreed.

Council approved AJ's fireworks application.

Councilman Croucher made a motion to approve ordinances 23 & 24 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 7:50 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Croucher. Councilman Barnes made a motion to call the question. Motion seconded by Councilman Lester. Motion passed 2 – 0 Original motion to adjourn the meeting failed 2 – 3 (Barnes, Lester, Hulsopple)

Mayor Burkdoll recognized Chad Myrick. Mr. Myrick asked the council to be the judges at the BBQ contest during Saturday in the Park from 11:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Council told him that they would have to get back with him.

Councilman Lester made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 7:58 p.m. Motion was seconded by Councilman Mayfield. Motion carried 5 – 0
