Minutes for the
Special Call Meeting
of the Governing Body
Thursday April 3, 2008

The meeting was called to order by Council President David Barnes at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were; Councilmen Ken Croucher, Eddie Lester, David Barnes, Larry Hulsopple and Jack Mayfield city attorney Mark Works, employees Bobi Morris, Frank Heiman and Ken Silver, citizens Jason Hardin, Jim Jones, Shawn Wilson, Keith & Betsy Crispin.

Mayor Burkdoll arrived at 7:01 p.m.

Old Business: Mayor Burkdoll recognized Jason Hardin with Crossroads Wireless. Mr. Hardin and the council discussed an agreement to allow Crossroads to attach an antenna on the water tower. Councilman Barnes made motion at 7:03 p.m. to go into a ten-minute executive session with Mark Works present to discuss legal issue. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 4 – 1 (Lester). Council returned to regular session at 7:13 p.m. Discussion with Mr. Hardin continued. Councilman Barnes made a motion to approve the contract with Crossroads as long there is a written agreement from Utility Services (and approved by Mark Works) that the cities maintenance rates will not increase do to the addition to the tower. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Motion amended to include a written agreement (approved by Mark Works) from Crossroads that they will comply with all of Utility Services' specifications for mounting the antenna on the tower. Carried 3 – 2 (Croucher, Mayfield) Mr. Hardin left the meeting.

Mayor Burkdoll canceled the police chief interviews due to the applicants not being present.

Councilman Croucher made a motion to adjourn the special call meeting at 7:55 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0.
