

**City of Scranton**  
**Minutes for the Meeting**  
**of the Governing Body**  
**Tuesday February 16, 2010**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor David Barnes at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmen; Eddie Lester, Larry Hulsopple, Jack Mayfield, and Randy Jackson. Gary DeShazer absent. Employees; Lois Berry, Bobi Morris, Scott Lester and Jon Reed. Citizens; Ken Croucher, Tom Carnes, Robert Laubach, Betsy Crispin, and Jeanne Johnson.

A motion was made by Councilman Hulsopple to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting on February 2, 2010 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Motion carried 5 – 0

**Old Business;** Mayor Barnes recognized Robert Laubach. Pat Cox informed the council that he had already visited with Mr. Laubach and his complaint was being handled. Robert Laubach, Rodger Franks and Tom Wells all had damage to their property caused by Mayer Specialties heavy equipment. Pat assured the council and property owners that when the weather permitted the property would be restored to “as good or better” condition.

City clerk misunderstood Donna Crawford; she will be attending the first meeting in March.

**New Business;** Councilman Mayfield made a motion at 7:21 p.m. to go in to a ten-minute executive session with Todd Luckman and Jon Reed to discuss non-elected personnel issue. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 4 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 7:31 p.m.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to accept Jon Reed’s resignation. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 3 – 1 (Lester)

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to change Marty Kane’s part-time status to an “as needed” status and change Gary Williams from “as needed” to part-time status effective February 22, 2010. Motion was second by Councilman Lester. Carried 4 – 0

Nine fire fighters will be attending the annual SCAFFA training for a total of thirty hours.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to trade bunker gear for fire hose with the Burlingame Fire Department. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Lester made a motion to approve the purchase of a \$199.00 trauma bag for the fire department. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Lester made a motion to place Herbert Spencer on permanent full-time status. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve \$150.00 for winter clothing for the maintenance department. Motion was second by Councilman Lester. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve two days for Data Tech training in the clerk's office. Motion was second by Councilman Lester. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Jackson made a motion to approve forty hours a week for the next two weeks for the assistant clerk. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to place ads in the Herald, League of Kansas Municipalities website and on free internet sites for a Police Chief. Motion was second by Councilman Lester. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion at 8:23 p.m. to go in to a ten-minute executive session with Todd Luckman and call in Harold Cox for attorney-client privilege. Motion was second by Councilman Lester. Carried 4 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 8:33 p.m. Councilman Hulsopple made a motion at 8:34 p.m. to return to executive session for five additional minutes. Motion was second by Councilman Lester. Carried 4 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 8:39 p.m.

Todd Luckman announced that Jon "Kelly" Ewing had made a claim against the city on October 30, 2009 and the city had 120 days to respond.

Councilman Hulsopple was instructed to get bids for the community building floor and door.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve ordinances 7 & 8 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Lester. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Lester made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 8:46 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0
