Minutes for the Meeting
of the Governing Body
Tuesday February 5, 2013

The meeting was called to order by Mayor David Barnes at 6:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmen; Randy Jackson, Robert Sims, Randy Ming & Larry Hulsopple. Councilman DeShazer is absent. Employees; Larry Alexander, Bobi Morris and Scott Lester. Citizens; Tom Carnes, Marshall Madill, Betsy Crispin, Ken Croucher and Gabe Faimon.

A motion was made by Councilman Hulsopple to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of January 15, 2013 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 4 – 0.

Old Business; Marshall Madill with Integrity Insurance gave the council an update on the city insurance.

New Business; President of the USD 434 School Board, Randy Boudeman, discussed the new bond issue that will be on the ballot in April.

Coleen McDowell was recognized. Ms McDowell was not present.

Ken Croucher gave the Fire report.

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to approve up to \$200.00 for the fireman's annual training and the use of the community building on March 10th. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0

Scott Lester gave the Maintenance report.

Councilman Sims made a motion at 6:41 p.m. to go in to a five (5) minute executive session with Scott Lester present to discuss non-elected personnel issue. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 4 – 0 Council returned to regular session at 6:46 p.m.

Councilman Jackson made a motion to hire Jerry Atchison as a temporary part-time maintenance worker at \$9.50 an hour. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0

After successfully completing the ninety day probationary period Councilman Jackson made a motion to change Kyle Cox's status to permanent full-time effective immediately. Motion was second by Councilman Sims. Carried 4 – 0

Larry Alexander gave the Police report. He informed the council that he was changing Officer Cox's title from Sergeant to Assistant Chief. It is a title change needed to allow Cox to take training that he otherwise would not qualify for.

Councilman DeShazer arrives at 6:50 p.m.

Councilman Jackson made a motion to approve temporary electric service for 414 W Evergreen St. and a building permit needs to be obtained within forty-five days (March 20, 2013). Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to pay \$50.00 to Mid

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to hire Mid-West Exterminators of Kansas Inc. to do the extermination treatments of the community building and the city offices for \$25.00 (each) a month. Motion was second by Councilman Sims. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman DeShazer made a motion at 7:05 p.m. to go in to a five (5) minute executive session with Bobi Morris present to discuss non-elected personal issue. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 5 – 0 Council returned to regular session at 7:10 p.m.

Councilman Jackson made a motion to hire Jean White as a temporary part-time assistant clerk. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to place employment ads in the Herald Chronicle for the treasurer and maintenance positions. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 - 0

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to approve ordinances 3 & 4 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Sims made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 7:13 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 5 – 0
