

**City of Scranton**  
**Minutes for the Meeting**  
**of the Governing Body**  
**Tuesday March 16, 2010**

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to elect Councilman Lester as the temporary council president due to the absence of the Mayor and Council President Jackson. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 3 – 0 – 1 (Lester abstained)

The meeting was called to order by Councilman Lester at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmen; Larry Hulsopple, Jack Mayfield, Gary DeShazer and Eddie Lester. Employees; Bobi Morris and Scott Lester. Citizens; Donna Crawford, Tom Carnes, Betsy Crispin, Frank Stokes, Ken Croucher, Gabe Faimon, Joe & Joyce Greene and Emery Elliott.

A motion was made by Councilman Hulsopple to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting on March 2, 2010 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Motion carried 3 – 0 – 1 (Lester abstained)

A motion was made by Councilman DeShazer to approve the minutes for the special call meeting on March 6, 2010 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Motion carried 3 – 0 – 1 (Hulsopple abstained)

**Old Business;** Councilman Lester recognized Donna Crawford. Ms Crawford reviewed the Purchasing Policy, Civil Rights, Code of Ethics and Procurement procedures for the 2010 sewer grant from DOC. The city already had a Code of Ethics in place.

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to approve and authorize the Mayor to sign the Official Procedures for Civil Rights complaints. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to approve and authorize the mayor to sign the Procurement Procedure Policy. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to approve and authorize the mayor to sign the City's Purchasing Policy. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 4 – 0

Ms Crawford left the meeting at 7:14 p.m.

Council discussed the annual clean-up day with Joe and Joyce Greene. Council approved the three truck minimum at \$550.00 a truck. The date was set for June 26<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 a.m. No tires, no brush, no chemicals, or refrigerated appliances that are not tagged by someone licensed to remove the Freon. Pick up will not include anything the

Land Fill doesn't allow. Osage Waste Disposal made a \$100.00 donation to the annual Easter Egg Hunt.

**New Business;** Councilman Lester gave the floor to David Thompson. Mr. Thompson was there to alert the city as to the changes being proposed by the County regarding county road maintenance and the impact it is going to have on the mill levy for Scranton citizens. 8.5 mils are being estimated. The citizens are currently paying 0.697 mills. Mr. Thompson left the meeting at 7:26 p.m.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion at 7:28 p.m. to go in to a twenty-minute executive session with Todd Luckman present and may call Bobi Morris in to discuss non-elected personnel issues. Motion was second by Councilman DeShazer. Carried 4 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 7:48 p.m. Issues not resolved.

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to return to executive session at 7:49 p.m. for ten-minutes to continue discussion about non-elected personnel issues. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 4 – 0 Council returned to regular session at 7:59 p.m. Matters discussed and Bobi Morris was not called in.

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to advertise in the Herald-Chronicle and on kansasworkforce.com plus any free sites for a city treasurer. Motion was second by Councilman DeShazer. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to have the radar units repaired and then properly installed by Liggett. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 3 – 1 (DeShazer)

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to approve ordinances 11 & 12 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman DeShazer. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 8:11 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Lester. Carried 4 – 0
