**Minutes for the Meeting
of the Governing Body
Tuesday May 18, 2010**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor David Barnes at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmen; Larry Hulsopple, Jack Mayfield, Gary DeShazer, Randy Jackson and Eddie Lester was absent. Employees; Brent Cox, Bobi Morris and Scott Lester. Citizens; Tom Carnes, Frank Stokes, Betsy Crispin, Ken Croucher, Gabe Faimon, Barb Prost, Stephanie Watson, Butch Akers.

A motion was made by Councilman Mayfield to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting on May 4, 2010 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Motion carried 4 – 0

Old Business; City Attorney Todd Luckman was instructed to make more revisions to the training reimbursement ordinance.

New Business; Mayor Barnes recognized Barb Prost. Barb and Stephanie Watson were promoting a guide to Osage County.

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to purchase a full page color ad in the Guide to Osage County for \$850.00. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 3 – 1 (Mayfield)

Butch Akers requested permission to live in a temporary structure while he built a new house. After reviewing the city code Todd Luckman recommended a new ordinance to deal with the issue.

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to have a special call meeting May 19, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. do address the temporary residence issue. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to accept sealed bids on the ambulance through June 11, 2010. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to pay S.C.A.F.F.A and not pursue collecting fees from the firemen. Motion died due to lack of second.

Councilman Jackson made a motion to pay S.C.A.F.F.A. Motion was second by Councilman DeShazer. Carried 3 – 1 (Mayfield)

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to purchase decals for the newly purchased fire truck in the amount of \$230.40. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield.

Carried 4 - 0

Councilman DeShazer made a motion at 8:18 p.m. to go in to a five-minute executive session to discuss non-elected personnel issue with Todd Luckman and Ken Croucher present. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 4 – 0 Council returned to regular session at 8:23 p.m.

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to recover the training fees from the firemen that did not attend the training. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 3 – 1 (Mayfield).

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion at 8:29 to go in to a ten-minute executive session with Todd Luckman present to discuss non-elected personnel issues. Motion was second by Councilman DeShazer. Carried 3 – 1 (Mayfield) Council returned to regular session at 8:39 p.m. Councilman DeShazer made a motion at 8:40 p.m. to extend the executive session for an additional five-minutes. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 4 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 8:45 p.m.

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to refund \$25.00 to Chelsea Kahle for the community building rent due to the dirty conditions of the building. Motion was second by Councilman DeShazer. Carried 3 – 1 (Mayfield)

Councilman DeShazer made a motion at 8:56 p.m. to go in to a ten-minute executive session with Todd Luckman present and call in Bobi Morris and/or Scott Lester. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 4 – 0 Council returned to regular session at 9:06 p.m.

Councilman Jackson made a motion to give the clerk and maintenance supervisor a three percent (3%) cost of living raise effective immediately. Motion was second by Councilman DeShazer. Carried 3 – 1 (Mayfield)

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve ordinances 19 & 20 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 9:26 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 4 – 0
