The meeting was called to order by Mayor Robert Sims at 6:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmen; Randy Jackson, Randy Ming, Larry Hulsopple, Jennifer Burkdoll & Gary Burkdoll. Employees; Larry Alexander, Scott Lester and Bobi Morris. Citizens; Pat Cox and Tom Carnes. Gabe Faimon (late).

A motion was made by Councilman Jackson to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of June 4, 2013 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 5 – 0

**New Business:** Councilman Ming made a motion to authorize the mayor to execute the contract with BG Consultant for the water infrastructure project. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Jackson made a motion to approve the development of a water conservation plan consistent with the Kansas Water office standards. Rita Clary from the Kansas Rural Water association will assist. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to adopt ordinance 635 increasing the fee for a zoning application to \$100.00. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 4 – 1 (Gary Burkdoll)

Councilwoman Burkdoll made a motion to adopt ordinance 636 changing the first council meeting of the month to a start time of 7:00 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to accept the Zoning Committee's recommendation to deny the Reinch's request to move a single-wide trailer in to the city limits. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 5 – 0

Councilwoman Burkdoll made a motion to accept the mayor's appointment of Raymond Morris and Rhonda Franks to the open seats on the zoning committee. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 5 – 0

**Old Business:** Councilman Hulsopple made a motion at 6:43 p.m. to go in to a five-minute executive session with Scott Lester to discuss non-elected personnel issue. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 – 0 Council returned to regular session at 6:48 p.m.

Councilman Ming made a motion to give Kyle Cox a \$1.00 an hour increase in pay. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 – 0 (Cox completed his water certification.)

Councilman Burkdoll made a motion to approve the purchase of \$220.70 worth of ammunition from CR Sales. Motion was second by Councilwoman Burkdoll. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Jackson made a motion to approve a request from Randy and Janet Watts to remove future sewer charges from their account on the vacant property located at 301 W Greenbrier because they had KC Construction close off the service. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 5 - 0

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to approve ordinances 19 & 20 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Burkdoll. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Jackson made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 7:27 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Burkdoll. Carried 5 – 0
