**Minutes for the Meeting  
of the Governing Body  
Tuesday July 20, 2010**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor David Barnes at 7:00 p.m.

A motion was made by Councilman Mayfield to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting on July 6, 2010 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Motion carried 4 – 0

A motion was made by Councilman Hulsopple to approve the minutes for the special call meeting on July 7, 2010 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Motion carried 4 – 0

**Old Business;** Councilman Jackson made a motion to adopt ordinance 615 changing the employee benefits at the time of termination and training cost reimbursement for employees. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. 3 – 1 (Mayfield)

Christi Miles gave the treasurer report.

Mayor Barnes opened a sealed bid on the ambulance in the amount of \$56.00. Bid was rejected and Chief Croucher is going to look into donating it to another department.

Mayor Barnes opened sealed bids for the Mercury Sable and the Crown Vic. The Sable was \$606.00 submitted by Beverly Brandt and the Vic was \$150.00 submitted by Duane DeShazer. Chief Alexander stated that Branine Motors would take both cars but it did not change the amount of the new car price.

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to accept the bid of \$606.00 from Mrs. Brandt for the Mercury Sable. Motion was second by Councilman DeShazer. Carried 3 – 1 (Mayfield)

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to accept the bid of \$150.00 from Mr. DeShazer for the Crown Vic. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 3 – 1 (Mayfield)

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to purchase a 2011 Chevy Impala (police cruiser) in the amount of \$21,992.56. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 4 – 0

Mayor Barnes opened the public hearing for the sewer project at 7:30 p.m. Pat Cox with BG Consultants addressed citizen questions. Councilman Mayfield made a motion to close the hearing at 8:13 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to authorize a \$250.00 spending allowance for Chief Alexander. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to purchase a 2002 Chevrolet utility truck for \$9900.00 from Mike Hodges Truck Sales. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 3 – 1 (Mayfield)

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to purchase a 2009 Ford F-150 for \$14,450.00 from Jims Garage. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 3 – 1 (Mayfield)

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to send Scott and Billy to the KDHE training at KU in Lawrence. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 3 – 1 (Mayfield)

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to take the sewer truck in and have the transmission repaired. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 3 – 1 (Mayfield)

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to approve the Drinking Establishment License application for the CP's Branding Iron Restaurant and Saloon from Gordon and Paula Schuler, pending the issuance of their state license. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve the contract with Todd Luckman on the sewer grant project. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to approve ordinances 27 & 28 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 9:34 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 – 0
