Minutes for the Meeting
of the Governing Body
Tuesday September 7, 2010

The meeting was called to order by Mayor David Barnes at 6:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmen; Eddie Lester, Larry Hulsopple, Jack Mayfield, Gary DeShazer and Randy Jackson. Employees; Scott Lester, Bobi Morris, Christi Miles, and Larry Alexander. Citizens; Tom Carnes, Betsy Crispin, Ken Croucher and Chris Brown.

A motion was made by Councilman Mayfield to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting on August 17, 2010 as amended. Motion was second by Councilman Lester. Motion carried 5 – 0

Old Business; Ken Croucher requested a check for \$100.00 to buy books and a money order for \$50.00 to pay testing fees for Jaime Stout.

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to approve trading a large set of fireman gear to Burlingame Fire for a smaller set. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0

New Business; Councilman Mayfield made a motion at 6:40 p.m. to go in to a ten-minute executive session with Larry Alexander for non-elected personnel issue. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 – 0 Councilman Lester left the session at 6:42 p.m. stating it was an illegal meeting. Mayor Barnes left the session at 6:48 p.m. and then returned. Council returned to regular session at 6:50 p.m.

Larry Alexander requested a ten hour a week increase in part-time hours. Councilman DeShazer made a motion to keep the hours at forty a week. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 4 – 1 (Mayfield)

Councilman Lester made a motion to set police reserve requirement at 12 hours a month (6 hours patrol and 6 hours training). Motion second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Lester made a motion to allow Larry Alexander to attend Laser training in Emporia not to exceed \$200.00 in training fees. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Lester made a motion to allow Larry Alexander to attend the Kansas Chief's Association training not to exceed \$200.00 in training fees. Motion second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Lester made a motion to place the same size ad as last years in the SFT High School yearbook. Motion second by Councilman DeShazer. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Jackson made a motion to name Gary DeShazer as the voting delegate and Eddie Lester as the alternate delegate for the League of Kansas Municipalities. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Lester made a motion to pay the dues for Chief Alexander to become a member of the Kansas Peace Officers Association. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Lester made a motion at 7:43 p.m. to go in to a thirty minute executive session for non-elected personnel issues and calling in Bobi Morris, Christi Miles, Scott Lester and Larry Alexander if needed. Motion was second by Councilman Mayfield. Carried 5 – 0 Council returned to regular session at 8:13 p.m.

Motion was made by Councilman DeShazer at 8:13 p.m. to return to executive session for non-elected personnel issues for thirty minutes and call in Larry Alexander if needed. Motion was second by Councilman Lester. Carried 5 - 0 Council returned to regular session at 8:43 p.m.

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to allow the school to install signs designating a one way in front of the school. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 4 – 1 (Hulsopple)

Councilman Mayfield made a motion to approve ordinances 33 & 34 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 9:13 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Lester. Carried 5 – 0
