Minutes for the Meeting
of the Governing Body
Tuesday November 20, 2012

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Barnes at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmen; Randy Jackson, Gary DeShazer, Robert Sims, Randy Ming & Larry Hulsopple. City Attorney; Todd Luckman. Employees; Larry Alexander, Bobi Morris and Brent Cox. Citizens; Tom Carnes, Ken Croucher and Gabe Faimon.

A motion was made by Councilman Sims to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of November 6, 2012 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 4 – 0 – 1 (DeShazer abstained due to absence.)

Old Business; Zoning issues for Habiger and Snyder property tabled until the city attorney can provide needed ordinances.

New Business; Councilman Ming made a motion to approve Kellen Lafferty to “ride-along” once and Travis to “ride-along” three times with the police department for educational purposes. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Jackson made a motion to cancel the regular scheduled meeting for January 1, 2013. Motion was second by Councilman DeShazer. Carried 5 – 0

Randy Jackson made a motion to approve the prizes for this year’s Lighting Contest (*1st place is free electricity for the billing that includes Christmas, 2nd place is \$50.00 and 3rd place is \$25.00*) and allow Jack Mayfield to use the community building rent free for the purpose of hayrack ride and judging of the lights. No city employee (or household member) earning wages of \$1000.00 dollars or more in the previous twelve months and no Council Member (regardless of city paid wages) shall be permitted to enter the Lighting Contest. Motion was second by Councilman DeShazer. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Hulsopple had a bid to have the community building floor sealed and waxed for \$880.00. Council instructed the clerk to get bids from Bob’s Janitorial and Cardinal Cleaning for their consideration at the next regular scheduled council meeting.

Councilman Sims made a motion to approve \$800.00 or less to purchase of a new Pulse/Oxygen Meter for the Fire Department. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Ming made a motion to approve \$90.00 or less for Fire Department supplies. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Sims made a motion to approve \$45.00 for the purchase of welding wire for the Fire Department. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to approve ordinances 43 & 44 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Sims. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Jackson made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 7:36 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 5 – 0
