**Minutes for the Meeting  
of the Governing Body  
Tuesday April 17, 2012**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Barnes at 7:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmen; Randy Jackson, Robert Sims, Randy Ming & Larry Hulsopple. Councilman DeShazer is absent. Employees; Bobi Morris, Christi Miles and Brent Cox. Citizens; Tom Carnes, Betsy Crispin and Gabe Faimon.

A motion was made by Councilman Ming to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of April 3, 2012 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 4 – 0

**Old Business:** Councilman Ming made a motion to hire Jim Vandevord to install a handicap parking space at W Mercer and Brownie Blvd for \$1195.00. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 4 – 0

Councilman DeShazer arrived at 7:10 p.m.

Councilman Jackson made a motion to approve Charter Ordinance 12-01 creating a Parks and Recreation Commission with the 66537 correction. Motion was second by Councilman DeShazer. Carried 5 – 0

**New Business:** Council reviewed written financial reports from the treasurer.

Todd Luckman discussed the KDHE loans. Pay off of the smaller loan was tabled until the next regular scheduled meeting.

Brent Cox gave an update on the graphics for the patrol cars.

Council instructed the clerk to contact the insurance company about the hail damage to city property.

Rodger Franks gave a report on 604 S Burlingame Ave.

Councilman DeShazer made a motion at 7:38 p.m. to go in to a two-minute executive session with Todd Luckman for non-elected personnel issue. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 7:40 p.m.

Mayor Barnes recommended an increase in pay, \$14.00 per hour for Brent Cox. No action taken.

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to give Brent Cox a \$1.00 an hour increase in pay effective immediately. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 4 – 1 (Ming)

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to approve ordinances 13 & 14 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Jackson made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 7:56 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 5 – 0
