

**City of Scranton**  
**Minutes for the Meeting  
of the Governing Body  
Tuesday April 3, 2012**

The meeting was called to order by Council President Randy Jackson at 6:00 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmen; Randy Jackson, Gary DeShazer, Robert Sims, Randy Ming & Larry Hulsopple. Mayor Barnes was absent. Employees; Bobi Morris. Citizens; Betsy Crispin, Tom Carnes, Sam Johnson, Pat Cox, Gabe Faimon, Ken Croucher, Darrin Briggs, Buffy Croucher, Jeanne Johnson, and Rodger Franks.

A motion was made by Councilman Sims to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of March 20, 2012 as written. Motion was second by Councilman DeShazer Carried 4 – 0 – 1 (Jackson-absent from that meeting.)

A motion was made by Councilman DeShazer to approve the minutes for the special call meeting of March 16, 2012 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple Carried 4 – 0 – 1 (Ming-absent from that meeting.)

A motion was made by Councilman Sims to approve the minutes for the special call meeting of March 26, 2012 as written. Motion was second by Councilman DeShazer Carried 3 – 0 – 1 (Jackson & Ming-absent from that meeting.)

**Old Business;** Pat Cox addressed the financial process for the Sewer Project.

Mayor Barnes arrived – 6:22 p.m.

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to adopt ordinance 631 increasing the sewer rates to \$30.00 for the base rate and \$2.50 per thousand gallons after the minimum. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 5 – 0

Sam Johnson gave an update on the sewer project.

Councilman Jackson made a motion to approve Resolution 12-03 authorizing membership for the City in to the Kansas Municipal Insurance Trust. Motion was second by Councilman DeShazer. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman DeShazer made a motion at 6:51 p.m. to go in to a twenty-minute executive session with Todd Luckman present. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 7:11 p.m.

Council wants the mowing bid with Piper Mowing to be revised to only include the current mowing season. A longer contract can be revisited next year.

**New Business:** Council reviewed a bid from Lisa Jolly for a handi-cap parking space on the North side of the Branding Iron. Council agreed to pay the construction costs but requested two more bids. Issue tabled.

Ken Croucher gave the fire report.

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to approve \$1312.00 plus shipping for the purchase of ?????. Motion was second by Councilman Sims. Carried 5 – 0

Mayor Barnes reappointed Bobi Morris as City Clerk. Councilman Jackson made a motion to accept the mayor's appointment for city clerk. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 5 – 0

Mayor Barnes reappointed Christi Miles as City Treasurer. Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to accept the mayor's appointment for city treasurer. Motion was second by Councilman Sims. Carried 5 – 0

Mayor Barnes reappointed Brian Scott Lester as City Maintenance Supervisor. Councilman Jackson made a motion to accept the mayor's appointment for city maintenance supervisor. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 5 – 0

Mayor Barnes authorized the boot purchase made by Larry Alexander. Council will allow the payment.

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to approve ordinances 13 & 14 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Jackson. Carried 5 – 0

Councilman Jackson made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 7:56 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 5 – 0
