**Minutes for the Meeting
of the Governing Body
Tuesday August 21, 2012**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Barnes at 7:01 p.m.

In attendance were Councilmen; Gary DeShazer, Randy Ming & Larry Hulsopple. Councilman Jackson and Sims were absent. Employees; Bobi Morris, Larry Alexander, Christi Miles and Scott Lester. Citizens; Tom Carnes, Betsy Crispin, Ken Croucher, David & Jo Babler, Lavona Lafferty, Daniel Fischer and Gabe Faimon.

A motion was made by Councilman DeShazer to approve the minutes for the regular scheduled meeting of August 7, 2012 as written. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 3 – 0

Old Business: Mayor Barnes recognized Daniel Fischer from Rural Development. Council discussed issues about the repayment of the sewer project loan.

Lavona Lafferty informed the council of the decisions made by the Zoning Committee on the Habiger and Babler requests.

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to approve the two (2) foot variance for the Babler variance. Motion was second by Councilman Hulsopple. Carried 3 – 0

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to adopt Ordinance 632 regulating traffic in the corporate limits of the City of Scranton. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 3 – 0

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to adopt Ordinance 633 regulating public offences in the corporate limits of the City of Scranton. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 3 – 0

Scott Lester gave the maintenance report.

Larry Alexander gave the police report.

Councilman DeShazer made a motion to approve \$200.00 to be applied to the FBI training being held in Lawrence for Larry Alexander to attend. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 3 – 0

Councilman DeShazer made a motion at 7:45 p.m. to go in to a fifteen-minute executive session with the right to call Scott Lester in to discuss a non-elected personnel issue. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 3 – 0. Council returned to regular session at 8:00 p.m.

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to approve ordinances 31 & 32 allowing payment of the city debts and payroll. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 3 – 0

Councilman Hulsopple made a motion to adjourn the regular scheduled meeting at 8:05 p.m. Motion was second by Councilman Ming. Carried 3 – 0
